Company Commitment

Community Alliance Credit Union Ltd (The Credit Union) is committed to providing a safe and healthy workplace and to eliminating risks and hazards that could result in injury or ill health.

The Credit Union requires its activities to conform to the Occupational Health & Safety Act 2000, relevant legislation and good established practices including Australian Standards. The Credit Union will provide its employees with guidance on and training in the identification, assessment and control of hazards in the workplace.

Consultation

Effective management of OHS risks depends on the commitment and cooperation of all employees. The Credit Union is committed to consulting with staff at all levels, in a meaningful and effective manner on OHS issues. It is the role of the OHS Committee to be involved in the implementation of safe work practices, promote health and safety and to contribute to decisions that may affect staff health, safety and welfare at work.

Responsibilities

The Credit Union expects all employees to comply with its occupational health and safety policies, procedures and guidelines, and to conduct themselves in a safe manner, not placing themselves or others at risk.

All Managers are responsible for the health and safety of employees working under their direction.

The Credit Union is also responsible for providing a safe and healthy environment for its Members and visitors who come onto Credit Union property.

Contractors working on Credit Union property are also required to comply with Credit Union policy, relevant OH&S legislation and conduct their activities in a manner that ensures the safety, health and welfare of others.
